Learn the art of building a traditional 6 to 12 Foot, by 10 to 14 inch, toboggan that tracks easily behind a snowshoer or a skier during two half-day sessions, Friday afternoon and Sunday morning. The slender design will be constructed of hardwood which students will steam bend, shape and assemble.

The thin wood's flexibility allows the toboggan to hug the ground for stability. Northern people have used toboggans of traditional design for hundreds of years. Join craftsman, Geoffrey Burke, founder of Chocorua Boatworks, to learn the skill of building toboggans. The group will be small. Some previous woodworking skill is helpful but not necessary. Cost: \$205.
