1. Sunday Film - *One Day in the Life of Noah Piugattuk*
2. Christopher Russell, Maine - **Make a Burned Spoon:** At Jack mountain and school of the forest, we like to use as little infrastructure and specialized gear as possible to complete our projects. One example of this is our burned spoons. Rather than using a spoon knife, we use a coal to burn out the depression of the spoon. A simple way to make an eating utensil on trail.
3. Bonna Weiler, Vermont - **Make Your Own Felted Mittens -**
Design and make your own warm felted mittens with natural colors of alpaca fiber and some sheep's wool. Wet-felt on a resist material, with the option to needle-felt colored designs after they are formed. Be warm this winter! **Must pre-register (See Form Below - \$20.00 fee)**
4. **Make An Ammo Can Stove** with Geoff Burke - This workshop will be all about stoves; the making of from ammo cans and other metal containers, efficiency in a stove design, sizing a stove for your tent, safety, stovepipe, setting up a stove in your tent, etc. It is also intended to be an open forum for others to share their hot ideas and maybe will be some smoking discussion in the form of friendly hot stove debates.
